Mass Air Flow Sensor

Your car's mass air flow sensor measures the amount of air that passes through to the engine and determines how much fuel to send to the engine. The leading cause of a faulty mass air flow sensor is poor air filter maintenance. For instance, *if you fail to replace your air filters regularly, then you are causing harm to your mass air flow sensor*.

When the mass air flow sensor stops to function as expected, they will cause your "check engine light "to come on signaling a major problem with your car engine. To avoid this problem, make sure that you change your air filters regularly. *While an air filter is cheap, replacing your mass air flow sensor can cost you a fortune*. Replacing your mass air flow sensor will cost you between \$400 and \$600.

Suspension

The primary purpose of the suspension is to hold your car together. It ensures that the harsh road conditions are kept outside where they belong and allows the passengers who are riding inside the car to feel comfortable even in rugged landscapes. A car's suspension system comprises of shocks, springs, control alarms, struts, and tie rods.

All these components need to be in good condition to ensure that the suspension performs its function appropriately. If one of these components breaks down, you can replace it at an affordable cost, but things might become tough *if the entire system needs an overhaul*.

To replace your entire suspension system, don't expect to spend anything less than \$3,600. However, make sure that you get a second opinion before you decide to splash that amount of money on your suspension overhaul. **Some rogue mechanics will recommend** *a complete overhaul when only one part needs to be replaced*.

Airbag Replacement
