2. Gather Vital Information & Paperwork

There are a number of things to get in order before selling your junk car for cash. Your first money-saving move will be to ***take the vehicle off of your insurance policy***. The next step and most important thing you need to do is ***transfer your vehicle's title (if you have one) to the salvage company***. This will prevent liability that may fall back on you since you are still in legal possession of the car. In addition, you will need to ***provide the following documentation and information*** to the salvage company:

- **Vehicle Title**
- **Valid Picture ID**
- **The Vehicles Make, Model, Year**
- **If the Vehicle is Operable**
- **Identify any Damage**
- **The Vehicle's Value** through Kelley Blue Book or the National Automobile Dealers Association

3. Remove Personal Belongings

Some of us tend to accumulate a lot of things in our cars over time. Devote some time to take everything out of the vehicle. Go through the glove compartment, center console, bins, back seat, above the visors, the floorboards, and underfloor mats. By going through the entire car and throwing away what you don't want, ***you are ensuring that you do not leave any personal paperwork with sensitive information or valuable items behind***. Also, take time to remove the license plates and visit dmv.org or call 800-DMV-UTAH for information about surrendering your plates.

4. Use or Remove the Gas

If your vehicle is still running, you will want to use up the gasoline in the tank before you fully surrender it to the salvage company. They will need to drain all of the fluids before the salvage process begins. If your car or truck is not running, use a fuel-safe gas can or container and a siphon pump to safely drain the vehicle's gas tank. ****Please note that there are dangers associated with manually siphoning gasoline.*** Dangers may include exposure to noxious

fumes, the risk of swallowing gas and the risk of fire. If you have no other way to extract the gasoline, ***please use the utmost caution and take the correct safety measures*** with manual siphoning.

5. Remove Valuable Components for Resale

It is important to turn your vehicle over to the salvage company in the same condition that you described. Make sure that you leave all of the components that have been included in your quoted estimate. But there are a few valuable components that you can remove to make a few extra dollars. You can ***sell or use newer or expensive tires with a lot of tread left*** simply replace them with balding tires on cheap rims. ***A new or almost new battery also has a resale value*** or can replace another vehicle's old battery. For those who know what they're doing, you can ***remove valuable stereo or GPS systems for re-use or resale.***
